HOUSING

Prince George offers a high standard of living. The cost of owning a home is less than a third of what it is in Vancouver. In 2012, the average home value was \$240,424. Prefer to rent? A three bedroom rental cost \$900 per month in 2012.

HEALTH CARE

Prince George has a safe and clean environment. You will have access to the medical centre at the University Hospital of Northern B.C. The city also has family doctors, walk-in clinics and the full range of health care professionals. A guide is also available to multicultural health services for residents of Prince George.

MEDIA

The Punjabi radio station in Vancouver broadcasts online for talk radio news on the community. You can also catch up on news from Vancouver and India through an online edition of the Indo-Canadian Voice.

Prince George has many options for childcare including child care centers and home providers.

StrongStart Centres offer free, drop-in early learning programs for young children and their parents.

Prince George has excellent schools. The Settlement Workers in Schools (SWIS) is a free program to assist the children of newcomers in the public school system. SWIS provides services in Chinese, English, Hindi, Punjabi and Urdu.

The Prince George Public Library has two locations, with free Internet access and other educational materials. For Punjabi speakers, resources include:

- · Punjab novels and short stories
- · Tapes, CD's, books to assist with learning English
- Resources for citizenship tests and other government programs
- · Free interlibrary loans for books in Punjabi

FAITH AND WORSHIP

Prince George is home to a diverse faith community. The City includes two Sikh temples, the Guru Gobind Singh Temple Association and the Guru Nanak Darbar Sikh Temple. The Temples offer Punjabi lessons for youth. Punjabi youth and seniors groups are available, providing an excellent opportunity to stay connected with the community.

MONEY TRANSFER

Prince George has national and international banks which can handle international transfers to send money back home. Local credit unions and Safeway, a grocery chain, provide the service as well.

HOLIDAYS AND SPECIAL EVENTS

Prince George hosts many Sikh and Punjabi cultural events. The Bollywood Dream Dancers perform at the city's Culture Show every year. The Sikh temples organize annual Diwali and Vaisakhi festivals, and Diwali celebrations are held throughout the city. The community holds an annual "Taste of India" fundraiser dinner for projects in India, attended by hundreds of people.

GROCERY

In Prince George you will have access to everything you need for that special homemade masala. There are large grocery stores where you can find nearly everything for the kitchen. Or, check out stores like the Dana Mandi which sells traditional spices, produce, and meats.
